Vegetable Cottage Cheese Salad

Recipe courtesy of Cooking for 1 or 2
Quick, Easy, Satisfying

- 1 package (4-serving size) JELL-O® Brand Lemon Flavor Sugar Free Gelatin
- 1 cup boiling water
- 3/4 cup cold water
- 1 tablespoon vinegar
- 1 cup (8 ounces) 2% lowfat cottage cheese
- 1/4 cup chopped celery
- 1/4 cup chopped green pepper
- 1/4 cup chopped red pepper
- 1/4 cup chopped carrot
- 1/4 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/8 teaspoon black pepper

Completely dissolve gelatin in boiling water. Add cold water and vinegar. Measure 1 cup gelatin mixture; divide evenly among 2 individual plastic containers or serving dishes. Chill until set, but not firm. Add remaining ingredients to remaining gelatin. Chill until slightly thickened. Spoon over clear gelatin. Chill until firm, about 2 hours.

Makes about 3¾ cups or
2 entrée servings
