



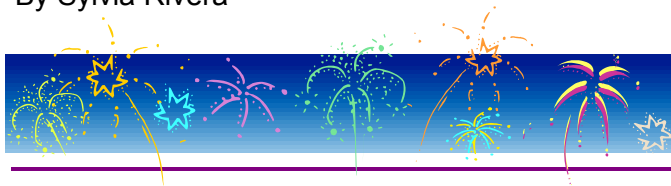
June 2010 Meeting Notes

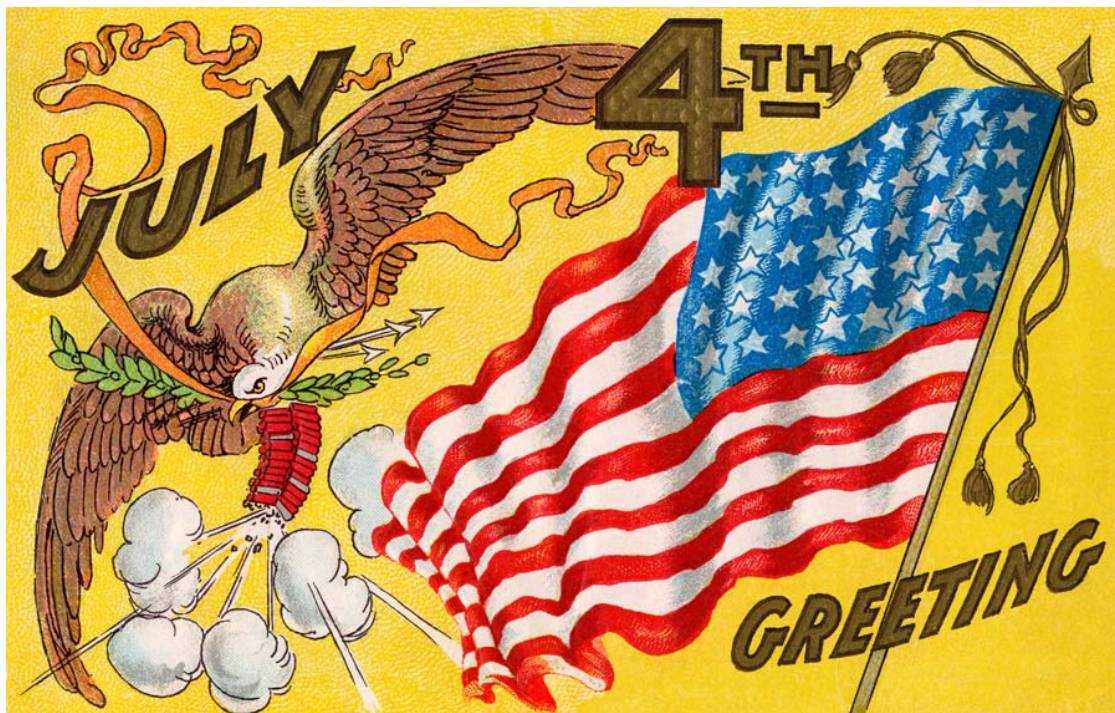
