### Garden Tuna Grazer

Recipe courtesy of Cooking for 1 or 2  
Quick, Easy, Satisfying

- 1 cup shredded carrots
- 1 can (6½ ounces) tuna, drained and flaked
- 1/2 cup diced zucchini
- 1/3 cup chopped walnuts
- 1/2 cup WISH-BONE® Creamy Italian Dressing
- 2 pita breads, halved
- 1 medium tomato, sliced
