Garden Shrimp Salad

Recipe courtesy of Cooking for 1 or 2
Quick, Easy, Satisfying

- 1½ cups broccoli florets
- ½ cup diagonally cut carrot slices
- 3 tablespoons water
- ½ cup snow peas, trimmed
- 3 tablespoons soy sauce
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 to 3 teaspoons sesame oil
- 2 teaspoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon grated fresh ginger
- 1 cup medium pasta shells, cooked and drained
- ½ pound cooked, peeled and deveined medium shrimp
- ½ cup thin red pepper slices
- 2 green onions, chopped
- 2 teaspoons sesame seeds, toasted

Place broccoli and carrots in 1-quart microwave-safe casserole. Add water; cover. Microwave on HIGH 2 minutes; stir. Add snow peas; cover. Microwave on HIGH 1 minute; drain. Cover vegetables with ice water to stop further cooking. Let stand 5 minutes; drain. Combine soy sauce, lemon juice, sesame oil, sugar and ginger in large bowl. Add cooked vegetables, pasta, shrimp and peppers; toss lightly. Cover; chill stirring occasionally. Sprinkle with green onions and sesame seeds just before serving
