Chefs Corner

Pumpkin Bars

- 4 eggs
- 1 cup oil
- 1-2/3 cup sugar
- 16 oz can pumpkin
- 2 tsp baking powder
- 2 cups flour
- 2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 tsp baking soda

Beat eggs, sugar, oil and pumpkin till light and fluffy. Stir together in separate bowl, flour, baking powder, cinnamon, salt and baking soda. Add to pumpkin mixture. Mix thoroughly. Spread in an ungreased 15 x 10 x 1" pan. Bake 350 for 25 to 30 minutes. Cool and frost with cream cheese frosting and cut into squares.

Frosting:

3 ounces cream cheese, dash salt, 1 tbl milk, 2-1/2 cups powdered sugar, 1 tsp vanilla. Blend until creamy and frost.
